IT'S SCHOLARSHIP TIME!

We are now accepting applications for our annual scholarships. Please review the following to determine if your student qualifies. Applications are available at the bar in the Rathskeller. All applications must be submitted on or before February 19, 2022. An awards banquet will be held in May to present the scholarship checks.

WALKER-DONAHUE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for students who are seniors in high school and whose <u>parent</u> is a paid up member of Waterbury Lodge No. 265. The only exception to the above rule is for children of a deceased member of this Lodge whose parent was in good standing at the time of his/her death. Note: This scholarship is <u>not for grandchildren</u> of members.

JOSEPH ANDROWSKI SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for students who have completed at least one year at an accredited two or fouryear college as of May 31, 2022. Eligible applicants must be paid-up members, or children or grandchildren of a paid-up Lodge 265 member. Children of a deceased member, whose parent was a paid-up member at the time of his or her death, are also eligible. Applications must be received at the lodge on or before December 20, 2020. Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, financial need, and overall school and civic involvement.

PAST EXALTED RULERS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for students who have completed the first year of an accredited two or four year college. Eligible applicants must be members, children or grandchildren of a member in good standing of Waterbury Lodge No. 265. Children of a deceased member, whose parent was a paid-up member at the time of his or her death, are also eligible.

The Elks National Foundation Legacy Scholarship Program is currently accepting applications. Please go to www.elks.org and hover on the Elks National Foundation tab. In the right column select "SCHOLARSHIPS" then click on "LEGACY AWARDS. All the information you need is presented here. The deadline for applying is February 7, 2022.






PRIME RIB NIGHT!

VOTE FOR BY-LAWS CHANGES DECEMBER 14, 2021

The following changes to the By-Laws of Waterbury Lodge 265 were read at the August 24th, 2021 meeting and will be voted on at the regular meeting on December 14th, 2021. All members are urged to attend.

Article X Sec. 1: Remove reduced Initiation fee in April and October.

Sec. 2, B & C, Regular dues will be raised to \$100. Life member dues to \$30.

Article IV, Sec. 1: December meeting is second Tuesday of the month.

Article XV-A, Sec. 1: Recognize Elks Riders 265 as Auxiliary Organization.

Article X, Sec. 4: Reinstatement fee \$50 and full year's dues collected.

Remove \$1 fee June and January.

Article VI, Sec. 4: Remove Tiler stipend.

In addition to compensation for costs incurred for national convention, current Exalted Ruler will be reimbursed for any other Lodge associated expenses up to \$1,000.


Article V, Sec. 6a: Remove wording of rental property at 235 West Main St.
